Leeds Palliative Care Ambulance Service

The palliative care ambulance was established in 2007 as a dedicated service for patients with palliative care needs in Leeds.

The palliative care ambulance is operated by Yorkshire Ambulance Service NHS Trust (YAS), providing flexible and responsive transport to help patients reach their chosen destination without delay.

Our aim is to reduce anxiety for patients, families and carers and ensure everyone is treated with dignity and respect at all times.

Our ambulance staff have received specialised training in caring for patients with palliative needs and the ambulance has been designed for comfort and relaxation, with the aim of reducing its 'clinical' look. There is also room for up to two companions to travel with a patient.

The service is available for people registered with a Leeds GP. It complements the existing transport that we provide for patients, such as same-day discharges, admissions and transfers to a hospice, home, care home or community.

How to make a booking

The palliative care ambulance operates seven days a week, including bank holidays, between 09:00 and 19:00.

Palliative care transport can be booked by any healthcare representative involved in the patient's care.

The service is available free of charge, 365 days a year, to patients who are registered with a Leeds GP.

To make a booking, healthcare representatives should call **0300 330 0263**

Lines are open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
