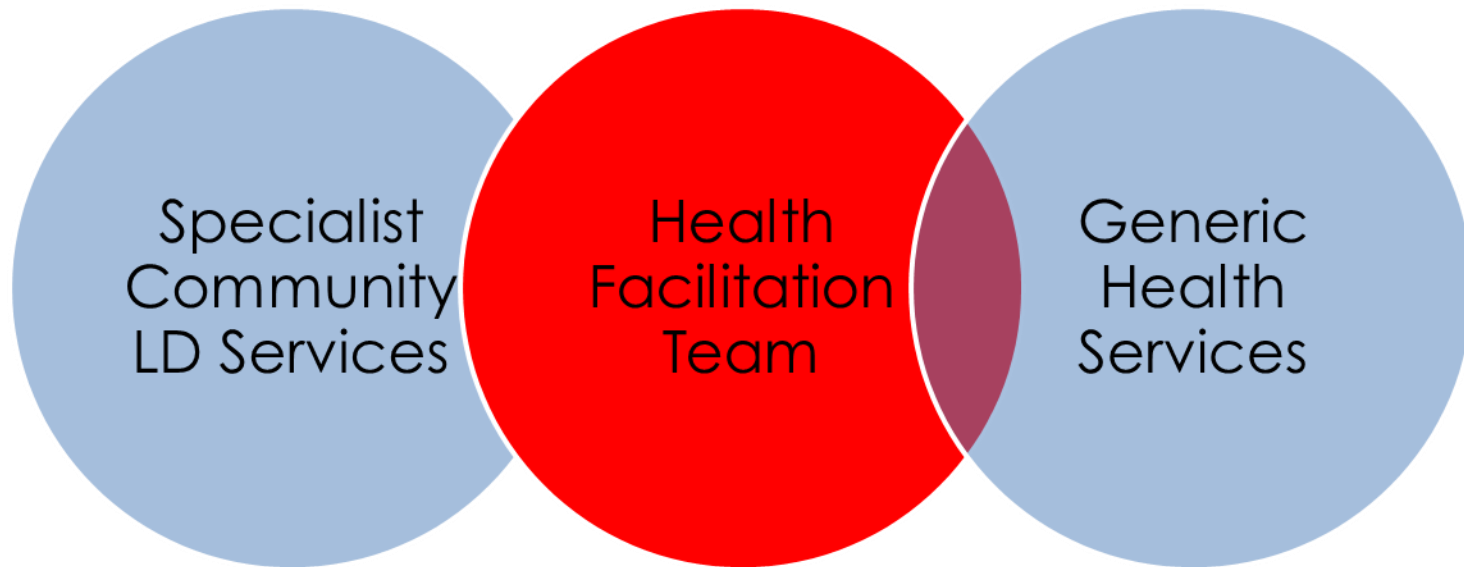

## The Equality Act (2010) - Reasonable adjustments – Care Plan



A reasonable adjustment is a small change a health service can make, to make your Health appointment easier for you.

You can ask for these reasonable adjustments to be available for you at your health appointment.

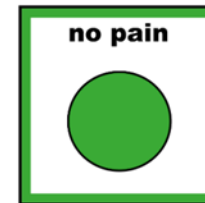
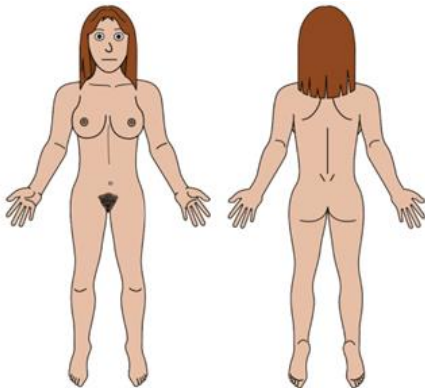
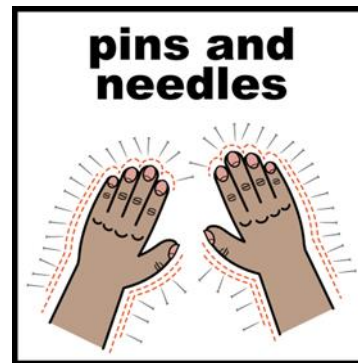
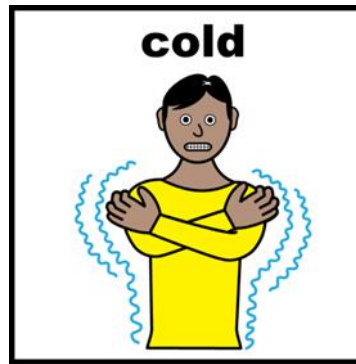
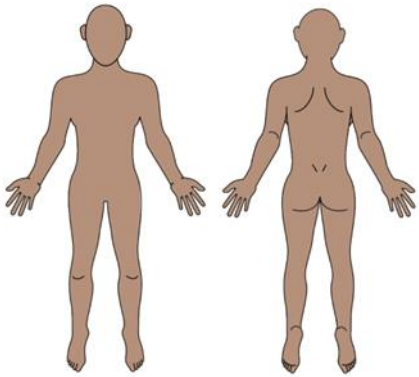

# What is the pain communication tool?

- Allows a patient to explain in an accessible format information needed to support the assessment of pain effectively. The communication tool was developed in co-production with service users with learning disabilities, due to the accessible format it could be used by anyone.
- Where it hurts – Body maps
- What it feels like – pain type
- How severe is the pain – accessible thermometers
